


***5<sup>th</sup> Grade / Rm.10 & 11***

All students are expected to think about the books read in fifth grade. One way to share your thoughts about a text and the author's ideas is to write a Response to Literature.

After reading a self-selected book, use the following outline and attached organizational structures (used in class) to develop a 3-5 paragraph paper. Remember to support your statements with examples from the text – and Revise & Edit your writing before turning it in on the due date.

**Writing Outline & Organization Structures:**

1. Pre-write "Brainstorm" story response
2. Paragraph #1: Introduction
3. Paragraph #2: Body
4. Paragraph #3: Conclusion

All Responses to Literature papers should first be organized using the above structures, then re-written and published on lined paper.
