

Volunteers needed for the Stroubles Creek Stream Restoration Project

Who? Anyone age 14 and older

What? Help plant native plants and install erosion control materials along Stroubles Creek

Why? The Biological Systems Engineering Department at Virginia Tech is leading a stream restoration project to improve stream health by regrading eroding streambanks and planting native vegetation.

When? Every Monday - Friday, 1-5 pm in September and October; Saturdays 10-12, 12-2, and 2-4



How?

1. Let us know you're coming by sending an email to Tess Wynn (tesswynn@vt.edu) with your name, organization (if applicable), and date and time you wish to volunteer
2. Check the project web site (<http://www.stroublescreek.bse.vt.edu/restoration.htm>) before you come out for any last-minute updates or cancellations
3. Wear sturdy shoes and clothes you don't mind getting dirty
4. Come prepared with a hat, bug spray, sun screen (water, gloves, and tools provided)
5. Take Prices Fork Road from Blacksburg to Plantation Road. Turn left and follow Plantation Road past the horse arena and over the creek. Take next right and follow that road until it ends at a corn field
6. Park next to the fence
7. Walk, bicycle, or wait for the volunteer truck for a ride to the stream restoration site
