

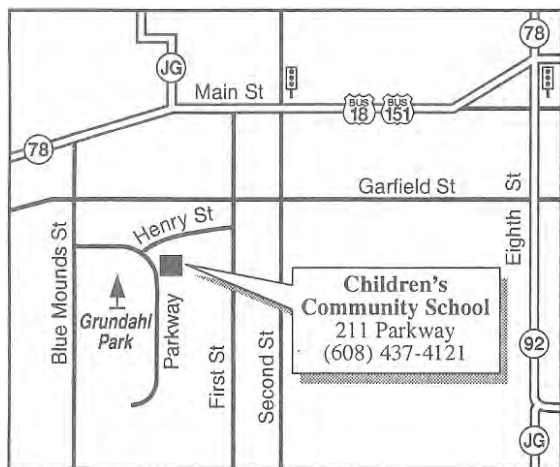

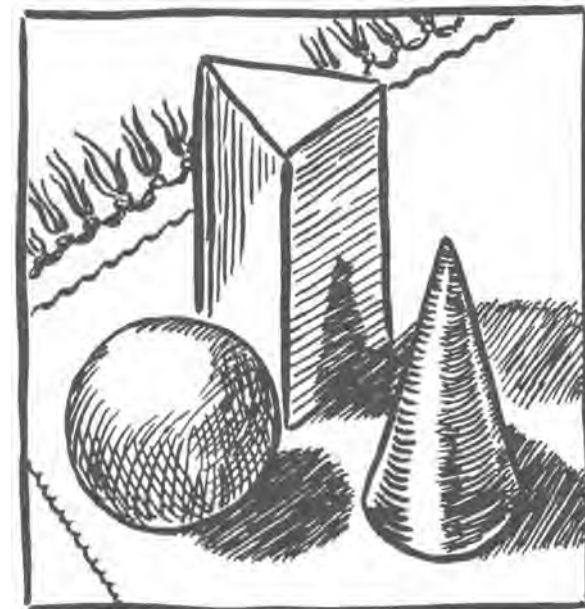

Your Child gains

- ◆ A good social, emotional, educational and spiritual foundation teaches motivation and enthusiasm for learning.
- ◆ A sense of responsibility to oneself, the community and the environment.
- ◆ Healthy social interactions with other children in a multi age setting.

- ◆ Curriculum developmentally challenging to each individual learning style.

- ◆ Hands on experience with unique Montessori learning materials.

Programs

- Choice of morning, afternoon or full day preschool for children ages 3 - 6 years old. Option for 3rd year students to remain through their Kindergarten year.
- A morning toddler program for children ages 18 months - 3 years.
- Summer Camp by the week. Full and Part Day Monday - Friday in our air conditioned classroom we offer special weekly themes... i.e. gardening, science, water themes, drama and fantasy play.
- A varied and balanced experience in self-help skills, sensory motor activities, math and language skills, science, geography, art, drama and music.
- Family events such as potlucks, picnics, parent meetings and coffees, frolic parade and grandparents day.
- Daily outdoor exploration (except in inclement weather).
- Nature study programs in our classrooms, unique playground and Grundahl Park.
- Community involvement through special visitors to the classroom.
- Parent education and child development opportunities.

Teachers

- Committed Teachers work in teams to develop well organized engaging lessons and learning environments.
- Excellent Teacher to parent communication and partnership.
- Highly qualified Teachers all hold early childhood and/or Montessori teaching degrees.
- Nurturing, caring Teachers role model respect and responsibility.
- Historically C.C.S. has had a very low Teacher turn over rate.
- Annually, Teachers obtain continuing education credits in the early childhood profession.

History

- ▲ Children's Community School, governed by a Board of Directors, has been a nonprofit organization since its conception in 1976.
