

How to Transfer Library ebooks to Your NOOK

- 1. SET UP AN ADOBE ACCOUNT FROM www.adobe.com**

From www.adobe.com, click on the "Your Account" link in the top right corner, then click the "Create an Adobe Account" box on the left side of the page. Fill in the required fields (an e-mail address, password, your name, city, state, and zip code are all that are required). **VERY IMPORTANT: Use the same e-mail address and password as your bn.com account. This will make authorizing the NOOK easier.**
- 2. DOWNLOAD, INSTALL, AND AUTHORIZE ADOBE DIGITAL EDITIONS FROM www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions/**

From this site, click the "Launch" box toward the middle of the page, and follow onscreen instructions. When the download is complete, ADE will open, and prompt you to authorize your computer using the same e-mail address and password as your Adobe account (and remember, this is your bn.com account information, too).
- 3. HAVE YOUR LIBRARY CARD READY, AND DOWNLOAD AN eBook FROM www.lvccld.org**

From this page, click the "eMedia" link from the menu on the left. Then click the "eBooks to Go Catalog (OverDrive)" link under the "eMedia to Go" heading. From here, browse or search for the book you choose to check-out. When you see a title you want, make sure you select a compatible file format (Adobe EPUB, or Adobe PDF...Mobipocket eBook is not compatible with the NOOK), and click "add to eMedia bag" on the right side of the screen. Click "Proceed to checkout". The following page will ask you for which library you will download from, your library card number, and your zip code. After inputting this information, select your desired rental period from the drop-down menu, and click the "Confirm check out" box at the bottom. The next page will have a link to download the ebook to your computer. Click the box "Download", then click the box "Open" on the pop-up window that follows. This should open ADE, and your ebook should appear in the ADE library.
- 4. PLUG IN YOUR NOOK TO THE COMPUTER, AND AUTHORIZE THE DEVICE**

With the ADE still open, plug in your NOOK to the computer. You will be asked to authorize your device. Follow the on-screen instructions.
- 5. TRANSFER THE LIBRARY eBook TO THE NOOK**

Your NOOK should be on the left side of the ADE screen now. Drag the ebook you downloaded from the library over to "NOOK" on the left side. Unplug your NOOK. Your ebook now should be in the NOOK library under "My Documents" (be patient as it checks for new content, it may take a minute or two). Open the book and enjoy!

READ LIBRARY eBooks

ON YOUR NOOK

1. Go to www.MyPublicLibrary.com.
2. Click on gray "Downloads" tab.
3. Under Ebooks, click on "Go to Overdrive."
4. On the left, scroll down to "Software Downloads."
5. Click on "Adobe Digital Editions" to download it ONE TIME to your computer.
6. Click on "Get Adobe Digital Editions."
7. Scroll down and click "Install" on left-hand side.
8. Follow rest of prompts to download Adobe Digital Editions.
9. Create a free Adobe ID.
IMPORTANT: Use the same email address in ADE as you used to create your Nook account.
10. Return to the library's Overdrive page to look for eBooks (try by clicking "eBooks" on left-hand side.
11. Choose a title.
12. If it says "add to waiting list," click, then log in with your library card and password, then enter your email address twice and click "add to waiting list."
13. An email will be sent when it is available for checkout, with four days to check it out before the hold expires.
14. If the chosen book says "add to cart," click on that.
15. "Continue Browsing" for more books, or "Proceed to Checkout."
16. During checkout, choose a checkout period of 7, 14 or 21 days.
17. After checkout, click on the "Download" button underneath the title cover to download to Adobe Digital Editions. ADE will automatically open on your computer.
18. Connect the Nook to your computer using a USB cable.
19. A Nook folder will appear on the left side of the Adobe Digital Editions window.
20. From Library Views in ADE, drag the cover of the eBook and drop it into the Nook folder.
21. Read the eBook on the Nook.
22. The book expires at the end of the checkout period, and cannot be opened on the Nook or in Adobe Digital Editions. Simply delete it from both.
