Robert Marzano's *Dimensions of Thinking*

Knowing: Identifying and recalling information
(list, name, label, recall, identify, match, choose)

Organizing: Arranging information to be used effectively
(categorize, group, classify, compare, contrast)

Applying: Using information for practical purposes
(apply, make, show, record, construct, demonstrate, illustrate)

Analyzing: Clarifying information by examining parts and relationships
(outline, diagram, differentiate, analyze)

Generating: Producing new information, meaning, or ideas
(conclude, predict, explain, elaborate, infer)

Integrating: Connecting and combining information
(combine, summarize, design, imagine, generalize)

Evaluating: Assessing the reasonableness and quality of ideas
(judge, evaluate, rate, verify, assess, define criteria)
