

Guidelines for Mrs. Barteld's Daily Warm-ups

- ❖ Everyday will begin with a warm-up. If you are absent you are expected to record a warm-up for that day indicating that you were absent. Every school day must be accounted for on your log. The type of entry will vary. You may be asked to just record a quote or fact, you may be asked to reflect on a quote or fact, you may be asked to answer a question, or you may be asked to draw something.
- ❖ Collect your folder as soon as you arrive in class. Return your folder to the bin at the end of class. (Remember that the classroom folder is intended to hold your current work. It **does not** count as your notebook!!!)
- ❖ Begin **each** entry by recording the date.
- ❖ Warm-ups will be graded on a bi-weekly basis. A percentage grade will be assigned based on the number of entries that are complete. Remembering to account for each school day will help you be successful in achieving a grade of 100%.
