**Colleges admissions recommend the following course work for success in college**

**4 years of English**

**3 + Years of Math (course work through at least Algebra II)**

**3+ Years of Science (course work in at least 2 of 3 disciplines of Biology, Chemistry and Physics)**

**3 Years of Social Studies**

**2-4 Years of a SINGLE Foreign Language (some colleges required 2 years for admission and 2 years for graduation. Some may accept 4 years of high school for exit requirements. Check with your school)**

**Colleges bound students might also consider their elective choices. All classes are valuable and provide a student with a well-rounded educational experience. Students are encouraged to explore courses in a variety of departments while in high school.**
