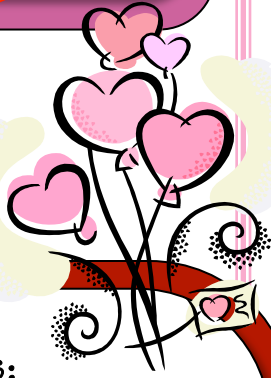

Reading: Independent Novels

Math: Fractions

Students will understand the meaning of decimal fractions and common fractions in simple cases and apply them in problem-solving situations.

- Understand how a common fraction represents parts of a whole and parts of a group.

- Understand the concept of addition and subtraction of common fractions with like denominators.
- Solve problems involving fractions.
