This week is Red Week!

Math: Chapter 1: Sort and Classify. Students will sort objects by observing one or more attributes as well as classify them through the use of logical reasoning. We will also graph our apples.

Language Arts: Theme 1: Look at Us: Phonemic Awareness: rhyming words and beginning sounds. Comprehension skills: compare and contrast. Vocabulary: naming words and describing words. Focus on previewing the alphabet. Continue story telling and interactive writing.

Science: The Five Senses: unit in science, we will explore how we use our senses by experimenting and using one sense at a time.
