- Math:** Chapter 1: Sort and Classify. Students will sort objects by observing one or more attributes as well as classify them through the use of logical reasoning. We are also working on equal, and more or less. We will make a graph for wearing blue.
- Language Arts:** Theme 1: Look at Us. Reviewing all literature read in this unit. Literature: The City Mouse and The Country Mouse, Mice Squeak, We Speak, Here Are My Hands, Now I Am Big, Let's Play, How Do You Feel? Daily message and shared writing. Finish previewing the alphabet.
