

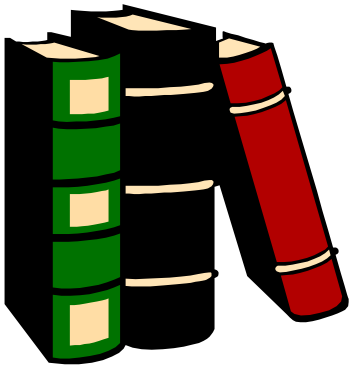
Book Report Brainstorms

Choose one of the following to assist your in giving your oral presentation:

- ❖ *Draw a cartoon strip of the most important events in the story. (see example on board)*
- ❖ *Make a soap, wood, or clay model to illustrate a character from the book.*
- ❖ *Write a different ending for the story and read it in class.*
- ❖ *Make a list of question your could ask the main character and present them as an interview during a news broadcast*
- ❖ *Make a diorama depicting the most exciting part of the book or the part you liked best.*
- ❖ *Dress in period clothes from the time of the story and give your oral report in first person as one of the characters.*
- ❖ *Make a word search puzzle using vocabulary words from the book, distribute it to all members of the class, after the class has had time to work the puzzle, orally explain how the words describe the story.*
- ❖ *Make a time line of events in the story.*
- ❖ *Make a crossword puzzle using words, using characters and places from the book; after the class has had time to work the puzzle, explain how the words elate to the story.*

- ❖ *Make a stitchery sampler, flag, or poster to illustrate a scene from the book.*
- ❖ *Write a letter to a friend telling why you recommend the book, give specific instances from the book to support your ideas*
- ❖ *Pretend you are the main character and write several diary pages describing an important event in the book*
- ❖ *Make a shoe box filmstrip of an exciting event in the story.*
- ❖ *Use a wire coat hanger and string to make a mobile based on the book.*
- ❖ *Write and read a one-act play based on the book.*
- ❖ *Make a puppet to represent a main character in the book.*
- ❖ *Tape record an interview in which you or a friend acts as the author of the book.*
- ❖ *Write a review of the book for a magazine or newspaper.*
