60 pts on the content

On 3X5 cards, neatly write notes about

1. The title of the book and the author
2. Tell where the story took place and what time period it took place in
3. Type of book (fiction, fantasy, non-fiction, biography)
4. Name the main character or characters of the book
5. Pick one character and describe what he/she looks like
6. Did the character or a situation he was in, change in the book
7. Name one or two traits about the character and tell how you knew this from the story,
List each characteristic on a separate note card
8. Give your opinion of the book and tell why you did or didn't like the book
9. What age group is the book geared toward
10. Tell an interesting fact or lesson you learned from the story.

40 pts on each of the following:

posture (10)

eye contact (10)

enthusiasm, smoothness, and expression (10)

poise---going to and from the front of the room, body language (5)

gestures and mannerisms, not distracting (5)
