

3rd Grade Goals & Expectations

School wide AIMSWEB assessments

School wide assessments are done in the fall, winter, and spring for reading fluency and for math computation/facts.

Reading Fluency - Students should be able to meet the following fluency bench marks. Fluency is the number of words correctly read in one minute at a 3.0 reading level.

Fall - 80 WCPM

Winter - 100 WCPM

Spring - 115 WCPM

Math Computation/Facts - This is a 2 minute assessment of computation and facts. Listed below are the bench marks for the number of digits correct on this test.

Fall - 15

Winter - 24

Spring - 28

Accelerated Reader (AR) - Students should have a goal of getting 85% correct or higher on all AR tests. They should also try to make their reading goal for the trimester and make at the minimum:

Trimester 1 - Independent Reader, NF Independent

Trimester 2 - Super & NF Super

Trimester 3 - Advanced & NF Advanced

Math Facts

Trimester 1 - Addition facts 0-10, Subtraction facts 0-10

Trimester 2 - Multiplication & Division facts 0, 1, 2, 5, & 10

Trimester 3 - Multiplication & Division facts 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, & 9

Students should be able to answer 40 fact questions in 2 a minute time period.

Writing

Students should be proficient in these types of writings:

Paragraphs

Narrative

Report

Friendly letters

The grading scale used in third grade is as follows:

E 90% to 100%

S+ 85% to 89%

S 75% to 84%

S- 70% to 74%

N 69% and below
