

Oral Presentation

Topic:

Something that is of great value to you. It may be about anything or anyone. It may NOT be about your best friend at SHA or from recent years. You may choose a friend you've known since Kindergarten.

Requirements:

- 5 minutes long
- a visual aid to help create interest
- loud and clear speaking voice with proper pacing to enhance understanding
- eye contact made with each audience member to create a connection
- calm and mature posture to prevent visual distractions
- organized into 5 parts:
 - a) clear and interesting opening to grab audience's attention (good place for the visual)
 - b) a discussion of one reason why this is important to you
 - c) a discussion of another reason
 - d) a discussion of the last reason
 - e) a conclusion that clearly ends the presentation that repeats your core message of importance

Grading:

As this is your very first oral presentation at SHA and to help you do well in all your other classes this year, I have specifically chosen an easy topic so that we can focus on the structure and presentation portion of your oral presentation. See next page for scoring breakdown.

Eye Contact: (5 points)

Eye contact made with WHOLE audience: 5 points

Eye contact with SOME of the audience: 3 points

Eye contact with ONE person: 1 point

Eye contact with just inanimate objects: 0 points

Vocal Skills: (5 points)

proper pacing (slow enough to comprehend) with loudness and changes in tone: 5 points

too fast: -2 points

too quiet: -1 points

monotone: -2 points
