

How to Register for Red Rocks Community College Credit through Concurrent Enrollment

1. Visit <http://www.rrcc.edu/hs/concurrent.html> and click on the “What you need to do” link a printable list of the steps for enrollment. Note: because you are participating in concurrent enrollment, you need not be 17 years old.
2. Click on this form <http://www.rrcc.edu/hs/pdfs/concurrentEnrollment.pdf> for more information and for further steps. A link to this form can be found below.
3. You can complete registration over the summer. According to Ms. Ysais, “If [you] decide to come to our campus over the summer, we will complete all steps including registration while [you] are here.” The walk-in RRCC Testing Center is open on the campus for the Accuplacer. The hours are:

Monday-Thursday: 9:00-7:00

Friday: 9:00-5:00

Saturday: 9:00-4:00

Although there will be registration sessions at RRCC in September, it behooves you to test and register over the summer.

- You will beat the rush at the registration sessions.
 - If you need to retake the Accuplacer to achieve the acceptable score, you will have many more opportunities. You can take it as often as necessary; however, you will no longer be able to register after 9/11/2010.
