

Behavior Expectations for First Grade



1. Be a good listener.
2. Sit nicely in your chair.
3. Help each other.
4. Be Kind and use nice words.
5. Keep hands, feet and objects to yourself.

The purpose of our class rules and discipline procedure is to provide a safe environment for children to learn and grow - an environment that is safe for them to fail and then learn how to get back up and try again. In this kind of environment we promote a mutual respect that is safe, orderly and conducive to learning.

Daily positive reinforcement for appropriate behavior is also an integral part our discipline plan. We use both group and individual rewards to positively reward the children each day. Rewards include but are not limited to:

Parent note home - signed Loss of turn Suspension from school
