ACT 2 & ACT 3

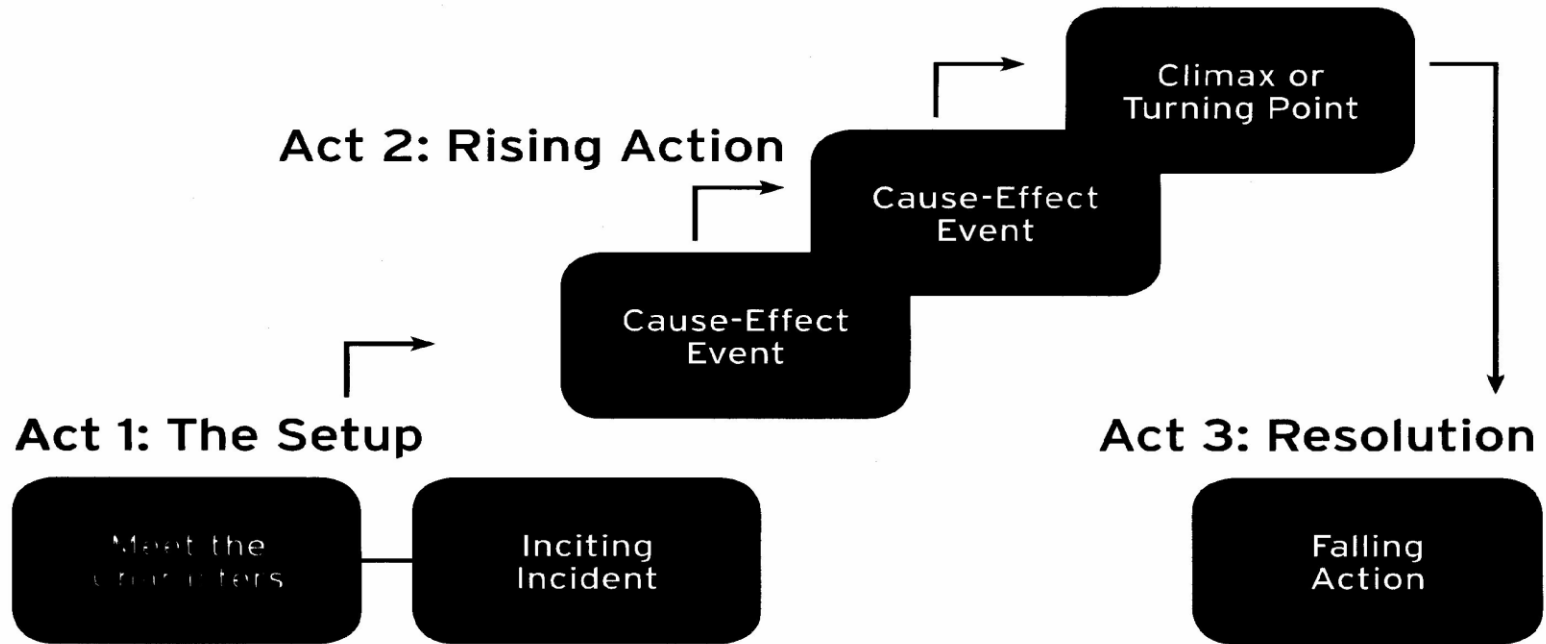
WHAT TO WRITE DOWN

NARRATIVE STRUCTURE – ACT 2 – RISING ACTION

ACT 2 – RISING ACTION

- ✘ RISING ACTIONS are the events that follow one after the other building suspense and the story.
- ✘ CAUSE-EFFECT EVENT –
 - + Actions that trigger reactions or other events.
 - + A story can have many CAUSE-EFFECT EVENTS.
 - + Taken together = building blocks of the film's PLOT.

ACT 2 – CONTINUED.....

- × CLIMAX – Is the “turning point” of the film.
 - + Most dramatic moment in the story.
 - + Climax triggers a significant change in one or more of the characters.
 - + Also a piece of the film’s of the PLOT.

RESOLUTION

- ✘ The final act in the film's Narrative Structure.

Has 2 important element.....

KEY TERMS: ACT 3

- ✘ FALLING ACTION all the events that occur after the CLIMAX until the end of the story.
- ✘ RESOLUTION is the outcome of the events that occurred.
 - + Sometimes positive, sometimes negative
 - + Can be implied through visual and sound symbols rather than stated directly
 - + Main characters have changed somewhat by the end of the story. Either they have changed personally or their view of others has changed.
