Students need to be able to take and organize notes for each of my classes. Experience has proven that keeping notes for social studies and global studies in two separate locations works out much better than mixing the notes together in a single notebook. I encourage students to use whatever system works out best for them. My only requirements are (1) notes are not kept on loose leaf paper but instead in a notebook of some type and (2) students keep their graded tests together either at home or at school, in order to study for the midterm and final exams.
