SAVE THIS SHEET

- HC=** Historical Context: During the same period of time as the events in your reading, what else was happening in either Europe, Asia, Africa or America (only use your social studies book but be exact in your facts)
- MMQ=** Monday Morning Quarterback: Now that you know what happened, choose an event or action from what you read and tell me what you would have done instead and what result might have occurred.
- ICD=** Identify Critical Decisions: Identify the top three (3) critical decisions in the readings and explain the reason for their importance.
- ULE=** Unplanned Life Event: Find two instances in the reading where what was planned/predicted did not turn-out, and identify why you think different result happened for each.
- COP=** Cult of Personality: Identify at least two individuals in the reading who were critical to the historical outcomes you read about. Explain why they were so important and what made them uniquely important to those around them.
- LL=** Lessons Learned: Based on what you read, what three (3) lessons should be learned from the events and results of the history you studied.
- M=** Map: Make a detailed map of the major events or locales described in your readings, using a common scale and legend throughout. Depending on the content of the readings, you may want to focus on a certain region as opposed to everything covered in the readings.
- YHTR=** Yesterday's History, Today's Reality: Describe how the historical events you read about, affect your life today or are reflected in the world today.

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
