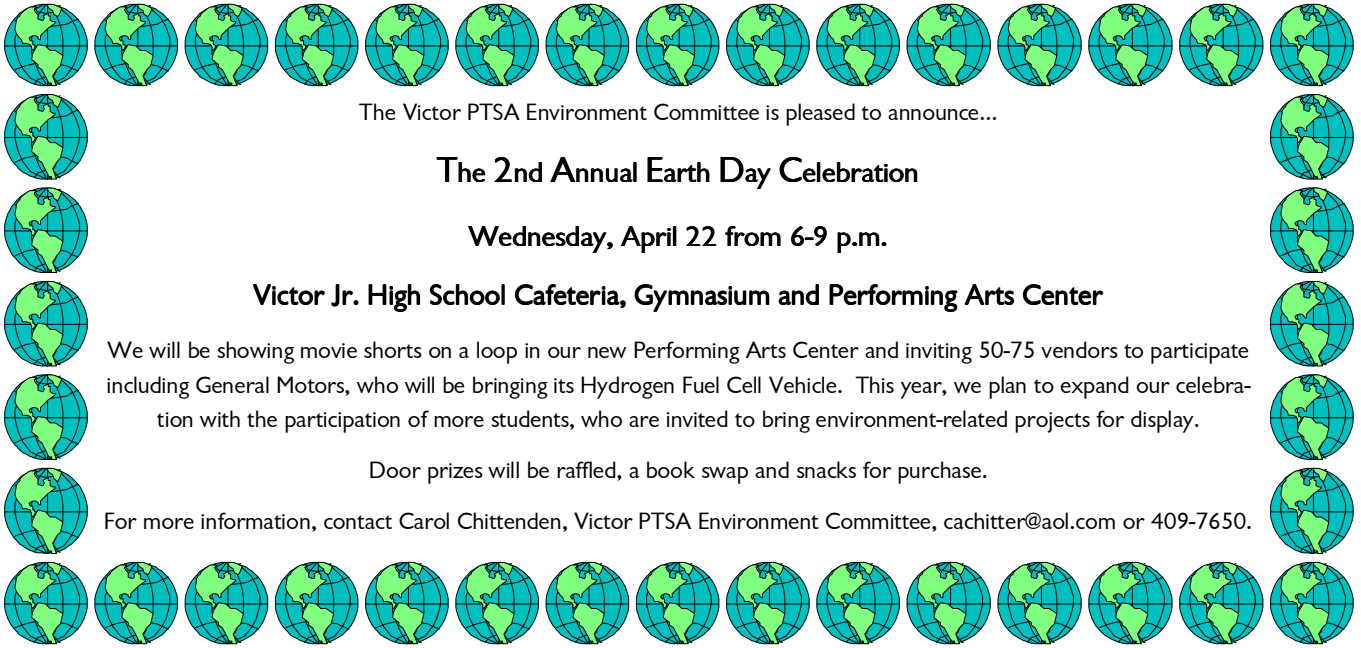

PTSA Reflections Art Program

The Victor Central School District is participating in the annual National PTA Reflections Program. Reflections is an art program which offers students the opportunity to create works of art for fun and recognition. Each year, a new theme is chosen from thousands of ideas submitted by students from around the country. **The theme for the 2009-2010 school year is "Beauty Is..."**

In its nearly 40 year history, the PTA Reflections Program has encouraged millions of students across the country, in preschool through grade 12 to explore their artistic talents. Students are encouraged to create original works of art based on the year's theme. Entries are accepted in six categories; Dance Choreography, Film/Video Production, Literature, Music Composition, Photography, and Visual Arts.

Thank you to our Victor students and their families for attending the Reflections Genesee Valley Regional Reception on January 16th at the School of the Arts where students were recognized for their works related to the 2008-2009 theme; WOW!

To quickly recap the event, Victor had 14 student's works which were among a total of 91 entries from the Genesee Valley Region. The participating PTA/PTSA units in the region were; Bay Trail, Bloomfield, Brockport Central, Eastridge, English Village, Gananda, Harris Hill, Lakeshore, Pine Brook, Victor Central, and Webster Central. From the 91 regional entries, 28 were chosen to proceed to the New York State level. Six of those chosen to proceed to the state level were our Victor students;
