May 2009

Environment Committee

Earth Day - We had a very successful event this year and were very happy to have at least one table from each school represented. We're hoping this event will continue to grow with student participants and that this becomes a huge combination student environment fair / vendor fair in the future. Many thanks to all who contributed to making it a great night!

Meeting with Dawn Santiago-Marullo - This week, we had our first meeting with our new superintendent, Dawn Santiago-Marullo. We made a Powerpoint presentation titled Victor Schools, A Sustainable Future, showing what a sustainable school is, who we are, and what are goals are for making Victor Schools responsible stewards of the environment. Sustainability is defined as 'Meeting the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their needs. This fall, we will be working with Chris Marshall and others to create a Sustainability Plan for the district.

We would love to make the presentation to PTSA to let the group know where we're headed. We need the support of parents, teachers, students and groups who use our campus to carry forward our goals of reducing plastic, Styrofoam and paper use on campus, recycling in every room, on every field, and at every event, monitoring and expanding our pesticide reduction program, and educating students and the community on living more sustainably.

Community Garden - We met with Danny Dehm and Chris Marshall for an initial conversation on the feasibility of starting a learning vegetable garden in one of the Primary courtyards. The vegetables from the garden would support the Victor Farmington Food Cupboard.

Young Entrepreneurs Academy - We have arranged for Dr. Tom Seager of the Golisano Sustainability Institute at RIT to speak with the HS YEA students on product life cycle analysis. Dr. Seager is a specialist in this area who will help make the students aware of the environmental impacts of decisions they make regarding products - from sourcing and transporting raw materials to final disposition of the product to a landfill or recycling center and beyond.
