OBJECTIVES

1. THE STUDENT WILL DEMONSTRATE THE ACADEMIC PRINCIPLES RELATED TO CONTACT PRINTING BY CORRECTLY PRODUCING A PROOF SHEET.
2. THE STUDENT WILL DEMONSTRATE LAB SKILLS NECESSARY FOR CONTACT PRINTING BY CORRECTLY PRODUCING A P_S.
3. THE STUDENT WILL DEMONSTRATE SUCCESSFUL OPERATION OF DARKROOM EQUIPMENT AND OTHER MATERIALS SPECIFIC TO CONTACT PRINTING BY CORRECTLY PRODUCING A P_S.

SPECS

1. SELECT ONE COMPLETE ROLL OF 35MM EXPOSURE FILM OR ROLL 120 FILM TO MAKE A P_S.
2. PUT NEGATIVES IN A NEGATIVE PROTECTOR AND PROOF THE SELECTED ROLL OF FILM ON A SINGLE SHEET OF PAPER. ALL OF THE NEGATIVES MUST BE IN ORDER AND FACING THE SAME DIRECTION SO THAT THE NUMBERS ARE EASILY READ.
3. USE A CLEAN PIECE OF GLASS TO MAKE YOUR P_S. MAKE SURE TO HOLD THE GLASS DOWN ON THE NEGATIVES SO THAT THE FINAL RESULT IS CRISP, EVENLY EXPOSED P_S.
4. FOR THIS ASSIGNMENT, THE STUDENT MAY USE HER/HIS BEST SET OF NEGATIVES DONE AT ANY TIME DURING THE SEMESTER.

MINIMUM LEVEL OF ACCEPTANCE

1. THE STUDENT WILL SUBMIT FOR A GRADE ONE P_S WHICH SHOWS AT LEAST 20 IN FOCUS, PROPERLY EXPOSED, PROPERLY DEVELOPED FRAMES.
2. THERE SHOULD BE NO WHITE EDGES ON THE P_S.
