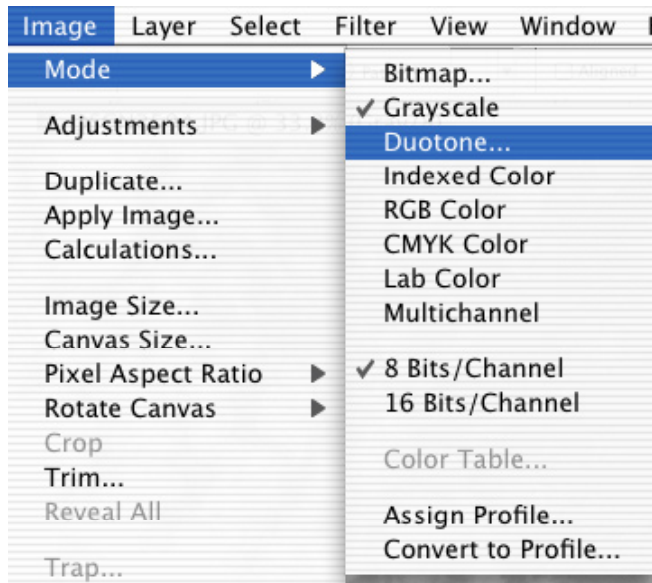


HOW TO: Duotones

- Choose an image
- If RGB: Image - Mode - Grayscale

STEP TWO: Image - Mode - Duotone

- 3) Choose: mono, duo, tri, quad
- four choices from a mono to a quadtone.
- choose Duotone



4) Choose two inks to use

5) Make a curve adjustment, if you want

(curve opens, make adjustments)

If all looks good you can save this duotone to use over and over again (click the save button)

OR: Use a Duotone Preset

6) Click OK

Have fun and experiment!!!

If you are sending this out to a CMYK print house additional steps need to be made. But for an inkjet printer or the traditional/digital photo lab this is all you need.

- create a hue and saturation layer
- click colorize
- adjust overall image
- click ok
