

## HOW TO: The Sky Fix

### Replacing the Sky

1. Select most of the Sky using the Magic Wand Tool
2. Select the rest of the Sky by choosing Similar from Selection Menu
3. Deselect the unnecessary areas with the lasso tool
4. Save Selection
5. Open a picture of a sunny sky, Select All, and Copy
6. Switch back to Original Image and choose paste into
7. If the Sky is too bright Change Opacity of the Layer
8. Create New Layer and fill with a light to dark Blend (Bottom to Top)

### Method 2 Using the Cloud Filter

1. Make a selection of the sky you want to replace.
2. Filter - Render - Clouds
  - the clouds filter uses the foreground/background colors you have selected in the tool color palette
- 3) Change opacity of the layer (if needed)
- 4) Create a Layer mask on clouds layer
- 5) choose a large brush - black color - reduce brush opacity - paint on the layer mask to create a pleasing cloud pattern
  - black/gray masks the clouds - white will bring them back
