A fat cat is in the hat.

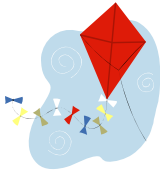
Words to know by sight:

flop /p/	rim /m/	ham /m/
lid /d/	bit /t/	jar /r/
fan /n/	laugh /f/	hat /t/

Point to the picture, say the name of the picture, and name the sound at the beginning of the word. (Ex: 1st Picture /b/ sound for the picture of the bug.) Pictures are: bug, kite, igloo, acorn, pig, donuts.
