

Dear Parents,

Welcome to the Third Trimester. In the short 12 weeks that we have left with your student, we have a lot to accomplish. Our goal is to complete the process of getting your student ready for the transition to middle school.

Our sixth graders should have a firm understanding of our classroom and school rules by this point in our year. We have introduced, taught and practiced what good character is. Thus, our policy of good citizenship and good character has some rules that must be followed for the remainder of the year.

We expect our sixth graders to be role models and examples on campus. For making good choices, our students are rewarded with some fun activities during the last portion of the year. The big trips for the sixth grade are our trip to SunSplash, and our Sixth Grade BBQ at the park. By this point in the year, your student knows what is acceptable and honorable behavior. Your student will be allowed to participate and enjoy these events under the following policy:

- A student will not be able to attend the sixth grade events if they are issued two Level 1 citations during the third trimester, beginning March 3rd.
- A student will not be able to attend the sixth grade events if they are issued one Level 2 citation during the third trimester, beginning March 3rd.
- A student will not be able to attend the sixth grade events if they are suspended during the third trimester, beginning March 3rd.

Please review the expectations and policy with your student. We ask that you acknowledge that you and your student have read and discussed the policy. Please return the signed acknowledgment by Friday, March 7th.
