

Introducing “Passport to Success”

Dear Millard Families,

We are excited to invite you to participate in a new volunteer reward program: **Millard Passport to Success!** Join us on an adventure traveling through the school year, exploring the many ways we can help make Millard campus strong and successful. Along the way you will make new friends as well as many fun memories. Plus, you will earn rewards for your children!



How the Passport Works:

1. Each student will receive a passport.
2. When you volunteer for Millard, you earn stamps in your passports.
EXAMPLES: Chaperone a field trip, help the teacher in or out of class, help organize or work at PTA sponsored events, take and submit photos for the yearbook, or attend scheduled school meetings (such as monthly PTA meetings or School Site Council meetings).
3. Students will receive “Millard Bucks” for stamps.
(4 stamps = 1 Millard Buck)
4. Student will be able to redeem Millard Bucks to “purchase” items from the PTA Treasure Box every 3 months.
5. Each student who earns 12 or more stamps in their passport by June 11, 2010, will receive a special invitation for a celebration party at the end of the year.

Parents, you are responsible for bringing the passport to get stamped or signed. The program operates on the **HONOR SYSTEM**.

- Volunteering on campus: Stamp pad will be located in the office for you to stamp your passport when you sign in to volunteer on campus.
- Volunteering by taking items home for teacher: Receive teacher stamp or signature on one of the “horse boxes” at bottom of page:
- Volunteering for PTA: Receive stamp from PTA Chairperson at event.

If you loose the passport we will replace it, however we will not replace the previous stamps.

By volunteering your time for our school, you will make our campus stronger and you will be able to experience how rewarding it is help our school.
