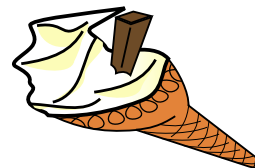

Ice Cream Socials

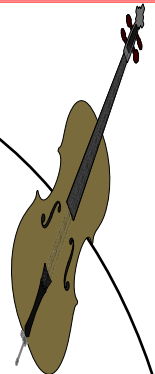

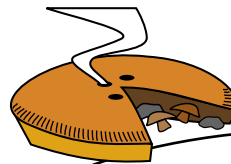
Box Tops for Field Trips:

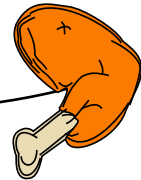
The Primary and Intermediate Schools have already earned over \$1000. Keep them coming!!!

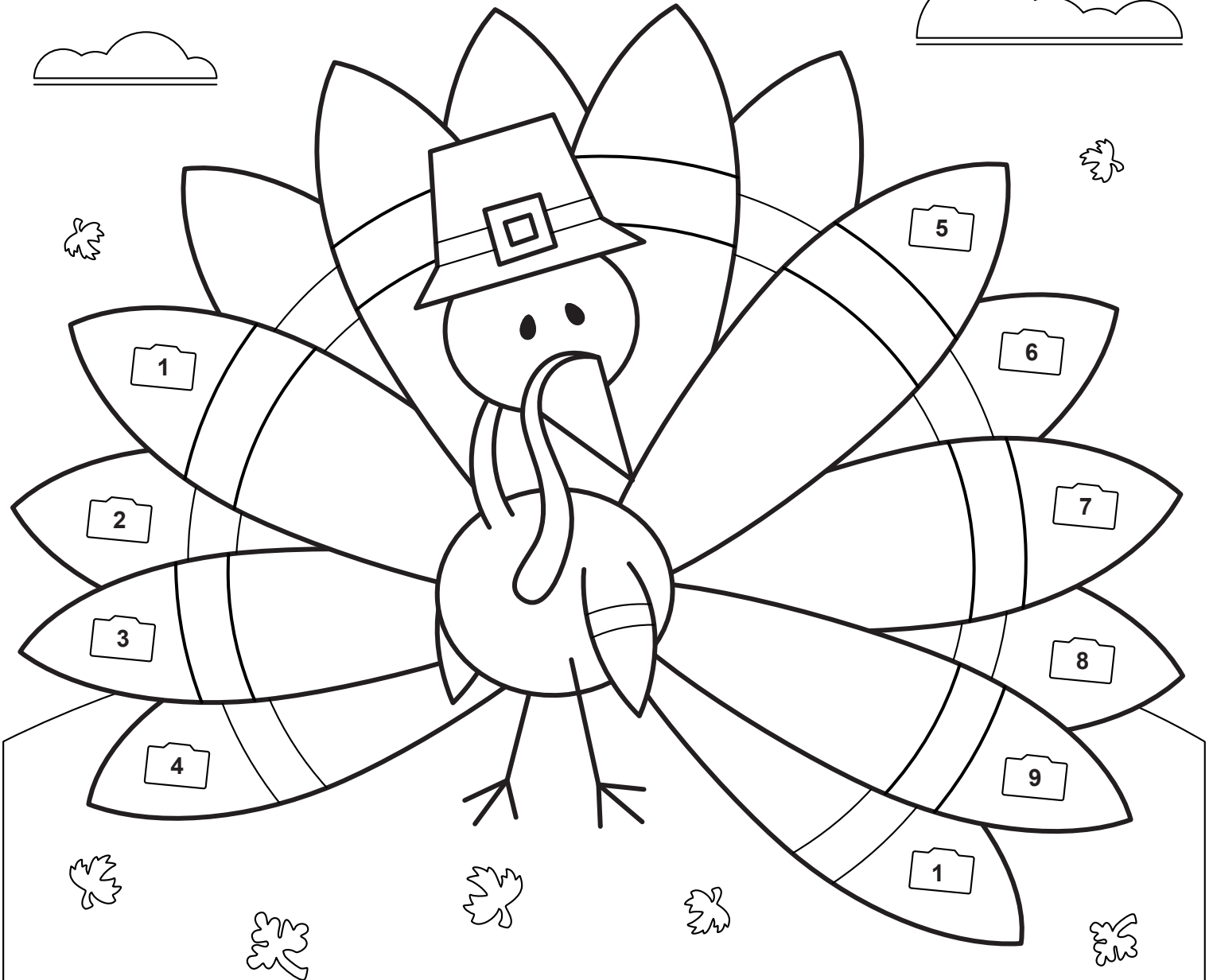
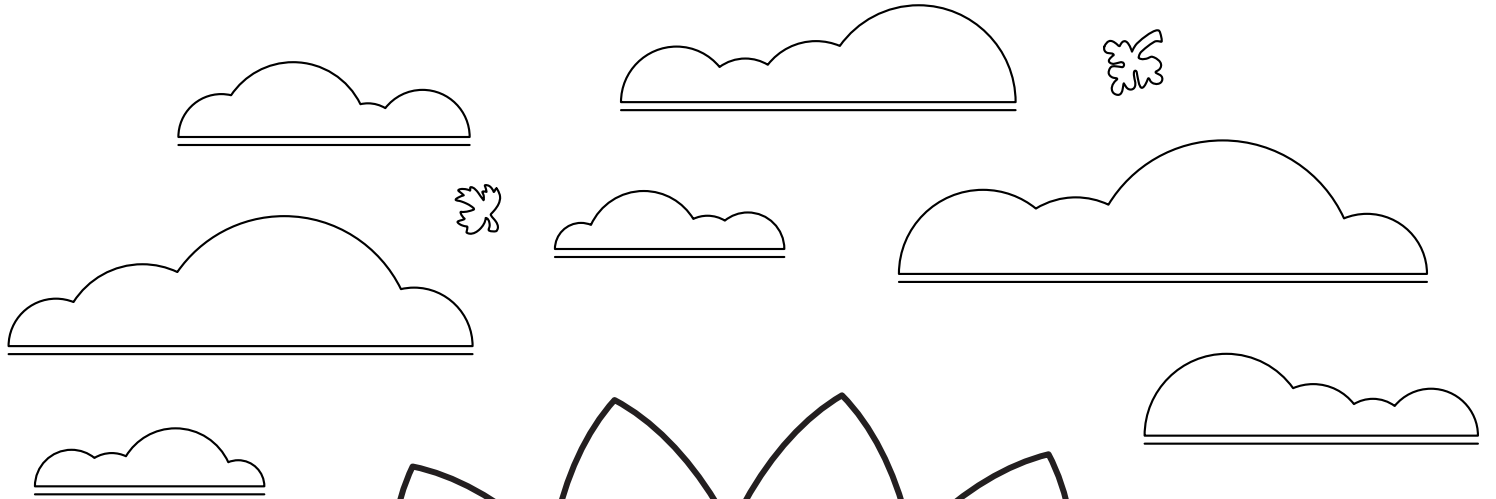
