- 1-Black and white notebook
- 1-One subject spiral notebook
- 3-Three subject notebooks (120 pages or more)
- 1-Package of erasable pens (black or blue)
- 2-Package of #2 **Sharpened pencils** with erasers
- 2-Red pens
- 5-Folders (2 pockets)
- 2-Folders with 3 tabs for loose-leaf (2 pockets)
- 1-Large Bottle of Glue
- 1-Scissor
- 1-Box of crayons or 1 Box of markers
- 2-Dry erase markers (**MUST BE NON-TOXIC, LOW ODOR**)
- 2-Highlighters-different colors
- 4-Packages of Post-Its (medium sized)
- 4-Packages of Post-Its (small size)
- 3-Packages 3 x 5 index cards (must be 3 different colors)
- 1-Box for 3 x 5 index cards
- 1-Roll of clear tape
- 1-Container for supplies (**MUST FIT INSIDE DESK**)
- 2-Boxes of Tissues
- 2-Boxes of Baby Wipes
- 1- CDRW with case for saving information on computer
- 2-clean socks to be used as a dry erase board eraser

AMOUNT	ITEM
1	Spill resistant plastic water bottle (e.g., sports cap). Please write student's name on bottle in permanent marker. This is important for daily use and for field trips. Please fill the bottle with ice water everyday prior to coming to school. No juices, sugar drinks, soda, glass or tin cans, please.
1	Fine- point multicolor highlighter
1	CD-ROM . . . . . labeled on the disk.
3	Large erasers
6	Small packages of tissues. Only one package should be brought in September. No large boxes, please.
1	Lunch cooler or box for those who bring their lunch and for field trips for everyone. This eliminates broken paper and plastic bags, and it reduces waste. Please write student's name on cooler in permanent marker.
5	Post-It pad packages in yellow, 5 inches by 3 inches
1 of each	Thesaurus. Dictionary. These should be kept at home for homework assignments.
1	Variety package of multicolored pencils
1	Compass. This should be kept at home for homework assignments.
10-20	#2 pencils
1	Small container with liquid hand soap for use at the sink. Write child's name on bottle.
1	Scissors
1	Small plastic container of Elmer's Glue
1	Plastic box to hold small items
1	Clipboard. Keep this at home. It will be for use on fieldtrips.
6	Black composition notebooks: Writing, Social Studies, Math, Science & Health, Reading, Word Cell & Spelling. Please label each notebook before the first day of school. The student's . . . . . of each notebook.
6	Portfolio folders: social studies, math, science & health, Word Cell & spelling, literature & writing, and notices. Please label each folder before the first day of school.
1	Transparent plastic ruler with both metric and English system (No designs, colors or drawings on ruler, please). Westcott brand ruler is one of the most useful.

PLEASE NOTE: No pens (with or without erasable ink). Students write in pencil only. No correction fluid. Please buy only non-toxic materials. Unless otherwise noted, all supplies should be brought to school on the first day. Thank you and best regards for a healthy and relaxing summer.
